Sub: - Regarding Grievances received on Examination result.

The Grievances received on the result announced by AICTE in respect to the 4 listed deemed to be universities were placed before the committee of the experts for examination and consideration. The recommendation of the committee are as under: -

S.No.	Types of Grievance.	Committee's recommendations
1.	Request for grace marks	The committee did not consider the request.
2.	Rechecking of marks in theory papers	The committee observed that individual candidate was given copies of their OMR answer sheet and also key(s) of answers of that exams question were finalized taking into consideration the objections raised by the candidates. Accordingly, there is no merit in the request.
3.	Rechecking and Re-evaluation of the practical exam	AICTE has sent a communication to all the institutions (NITs) where practical examination was conducted to cross-examine the practical marks. NITs have informed that there are no discrepancies found in the practical marks.
4.	Reduction of qualifying marks	The committee did not consider the request.
5.	Relaxing in passing marks for SC/ST/Physical challenged.	The committee did not consider the request.
6.	Out of course questions	The committee did not find merit.
7.	Challenging modalities	The committee was of the opinion that the modalities of the examination cannot be changed after the declaration of the result of the exam and accordingly this may not be considered.
8.	Supplementary chance for examination.	The committee was of the opinion that the modalities of conducting examination cannot be changed after the declaration of the result of the exam and accordingly this may not be considered.
9.	Mercy appeal	The committee did not considered the request.
